On **Saturday May 10th**, letter carriers in the Triangle will collect food items to benefit the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North during the **16th Annual STAMP OUT HUNGER FOOD DRIVE**. Local Food Bank branches are located at 3808 Tarheel Drive in Raleigh and 708 Gilbert Street in Durham.

WHY?

- 35 million Americans are at risk of hunger.
- More than 1 million are at risk of hunger in North Carolina.
- More than 400,000 are at risk of hunger in the Food Bank's 34-county service area.

HOW CAN YOU HELP?

- Look for a reminder postcard in your mailbox the week of April 28th.
- Look for bags in your mailbox week of May 5th.
- On Saturday, May 10th simply place bags filled with nonperishable food items like canned meats and fish, canned soup, juice, pasta, vegetables, cereal and rice next to your mailbox.
- Your letter carrier will do the rest!
